*DETAILS: Englert's speech will focus on the theme of "discovery" and Englert is expected to address the following topics during his speech:

1. Temple's record-breaking enrollment, 40,240 students are currently enrolled in the University; it's new ranking on U.S. News and World Report; its research grant awards over the past year.
2. The loss of Jenna Burleigh – the transfer student who was killed at the beginning of the fall semester.
3. The status of the development of the stadium.

This will be Englert's second State of the University address since assuming his current role. Englert has served in several different positions at Temple dating back to 1976. He became President of the University on July 21, 2016.
